Hi Everyone,

It's been a while since our last Rocks n Other Stuff newsletter, and I wanted to get you brief Ridgeline update after closing our CAD \$2.2M financing in May.

In case you didn't catch our May 30, 2024 exploration update click [HERE](#). This was a detailed update on all Nevada projects and a few highlights are noted below:

**Swift & Black Ridge:** Our partners at NGM have budgeted US \$5.2M in 2024 with the bulk of that spending allocated to drilling at Swift, which is anticipated to kick-off in late June

**Selena:** This is still very much our flagship asset, and we have a lot of confidence in the potential of the Chinchilla Sulfide recently identified porphyry target identified with our 2023 magnetics survey. Exploration at Selena is temporarily on hold until our pending Plan of Operations exploration permit is approved at some point in early Q3.

**Big Blue:** We will complete a 3D IP survey in the vicinity of the Delker mine and Skarn Hill adit beginning in mid-late July pending our geophysical contractor availability. This is an important step to identifying the deeper porphyry source that we believe is feeding these historic mines at surface. The results of this survey will dictate the next steps on a potential maiden drill program.

As always, our team is constantly assessing new projects and we have our eyes on a few we really like at the moment that are open for staking. We'll be busy in the field ranking these opportunities throughout the summer and will have updates to come in Q3-Q4.
